Stories are told about Cremona, still cradle of the construction of this ancient instrument; the Violin Museum, which houses some of the most important and priceless violins in the history of violin making; the Val di Fiemme, cradle of centuries-old spruce forests and especially of resonance firs, the same firs used centuries ago by the Cremonese school of Stradivari, Amati and Guarneri.
